



In June and July 13, the Lord opened a door that allowed us to meet the People of Jesus in Lima, Piura, Sullana (Peru) and Kinshasa (Democratic Republic of Congo). What a treat!

Our Lord used local leaders such as Pastor Antonio Garcia Dominguez Presidente Conferencia Peruana Hermanos Mennonitas and Donald Makasi, Directeur de l'Institut de Missiologie Papa Lumeya to bridge us with our Christian family in Africa and Latin America.

In both locations, Christ is Alive and Leading local Christians to go beyond cultural, ethnic, geographic, social, linguistic and spiritual boundaries. While in Peru, corporate holiness is part of daily prayer of Peruvian Christians, in Congo the Leadership is reflecting on Job creation as part of Gospel. Rain Forest is the Buzz. In Peru, the Encuentro Missionero of Sullana 2013 based the two day mission encounter on the theme of Unity (Ephesians 4:3).Our contribution consisted in tying the unity and holiness of the Peruvian Mennonite Brethren with God' s Kingdom. In DRC, the mission of our Fresno School of Mission team was to teach biblical Studies in the area of Old Testament Exegesis (Jeremiah), Sacrificial love (Ruth), Forgiveness (Life of Joseph) and Vacation Bible School (July 13). The team visited Women prisoners. After the preaching of the Gospel, 6 prisoners accepter Christ as their personal Savior and Lord. Their Chaplain accepted to fallow them up. Through Vacation Bible School, young adults were equipped. Local youth pastors are in charge of the follow up.

The 45 minutes on Christian TV allowed our Mission Team to spread the Gospel beyond Christian settings. The time of worship with local churches helped we encourage our Congolese brothers and Sisters to answer the call to follow Christ locally and globally.
